New SuperSail App. Version 2.9.

The sailing season 2021 is getting closer and at SuperSail we are continuously working to further enhance our SuperSail Marine Alarm solution as well as our SuperSail Yacht Telemetry and Monitoring solution for the professional market. Please visit us at: www.super-sail.dk.

The yachts are getting more sophisticated and many yachts are now equipped with a NMEA2000 network which is used for navigation and for displaying additional yacht information. From the Yacht Builders and our SuperSail Marine Alarm customers we are now providing the **option** to be able to show additional boat **Telemetry Status** information in the SuperSail App. Version 2.9.

- **Battery information** start battery incl. history
- Water Tank information- fresh water, grey water and black water
- Fuel Tank information fueltank#1, fueltank#2
- **Engine information** running hours engine#1 and engine#2
- **Generator information** running hours

In the **Version 2.9 of the SuperSail Owner App. this is now possible** – however the prerequisite for showing the above information is:

- The yacht is mounted with the SuperSail M-UnitC+ (a grey box)
- The above information is available on the **NMEA2000 network**
- The yacht is equipped with a **SuperSail NMEA2000 gateway**
- The yacht is equipped with 1 SuperSail Energy Sensor for Start battery monitoring - independent of the NMEA2000 network



IMPORTANT! The above is an **option** and your SuperSail App. continues to work as usual <u>without making any changes</u> to your present hardware configuration.

Please take a few minutes to familiarize you with the latest new functions and features to ensure you get the maximum value from your SuperSail System.

Version 2.9 of the SuperSail App will be available in a few days:

Our new Version 2.9 of the SuperSail Owners App. will be released to AppStore and PlayStore within a few days.

New functions and features in SuperSail App. Version 2.9

- Status for shore power #1 and shore power #2. Many of the larger yachts are now equipped with 2 phase shore power supply. Monitoring shore power requires, as today, installing a SuperSail wireless Shore power sensor for each phase. See www.Super-Sail.dk. In case the shore power is disconnected for more than 10 minutes the status field in the Telemetry Stratus section will change from green to red and an alarm SMS text will be send to the owner.
- Access to the SuperSail user manual and installation documents. The SuperSail on-line documentation is now available via the SuperSail App. You access the SuperSail documentation by pressing the button DOCUMENTS which you will find in the bottom of the new Telemetry Status Section of the SuperSail App Version 2.9. Here you will find Userand Installation manuals as well as a Battery Shopping List covering the type and number of batteries for the each of the SuperSail wireless sensors and the SuperSail remote control.
- <u>Smaller title text field text changes.</u> You will find a few minor changes to the titles and texts in the SuperSail App 2.9. which is included to make the SuperSail App. more user friendly.



Remember:

- The battery level in the wireless sensors is measured <u>every time the</u>
 <u>sensor is activated</u> (i.e., every time you pass by the movement sensor,
 open a hatch etc. both when the alarm is ON and OFF) and when
 activated an SMS is sent if the battery level in a wireless sensor is too
 low.
- However, we still recommend changing batteries in all wireless sensors
 once every year in order to ensure optimal signal and security. Use the
 new feature in the SuperSail App. Go to the Telemetry Status section
 and press DOCUMENTS, scroll to the document Battery Shopping List
 and open. Here you can see the battery type (ie. AA/AAA/ pencil) and
 the number of batteries which are needed for each of your wireless
 sensors and the remote control.
- The User Settings button is shown with a <u>red icon</u> in case no mobile telephone numbers are entered the alarm recipient list.
- If a temperature sensor is attached, the temperature icon figures will be shown in red, in case the temperature is not updated, i.e. if the sensor has run out of battery.

What to do:

- From AppStore for iOS telephones and from PlayStore for Android telephones you will **receive a notification** when the new SuperSail Version 2.9 App. is available.
- Your settings will **not be changed** when you install the new App.
- When the App. is installed you just use your present login.
- We recommend that you update to the new Version 2.9 in order to ensure that the latest security updates will be applied.



What's next:

Many of our users has today equipped the yachts with temperature sensors in order to monitor the onboard temperature. However, it is our experience that it is the <u>combination</u> of temperature and humidity which causes a risk of developing <u>mold</u>, especially in the bathrooms and in the below deck storage facilities where i.e. sails are stored.

Our next App release will therefore include the possibility to install up to 5 wireless sensors controlling both <u>temperature and humidity</u>. Via the SuperSail App it will be possible to set the humidity and temperature limits for sending an alarm.

We expect to launch this new functionality end of Q2 2021!
