Shortly SuperSail will release the **New SuperSail Owner App. Version 3.0.**

At SuperSail we are continuously working to further enhance our SuperSail Yacht Monitoring solution. Please visit us at: www.super-sail.dk.

We are delivering Yacht Monitoring Solutions, primarily within the premium yacht segment, and during the last year we have been working on the Version 3.0 which is the updated SuperSail Owner App which you use to control and monitor onboard status – i.e., being shore power(on/off), domestic battery status etc. and from which you receive alerts and alarms.

Version 3.0 of the SuperSail Owner App will be available in a few days:

We are pleased to announce Version 3.0 of our SuperSail Owner App which will be released to AppStore and PlayStore within a few days.

The Version 3.0 represents the new SuperSail design where we have focused on quick overview, ease of use and clarity.

Many functions and features will be familiar to you however we recommend you read this Newsletter and for more detailed information please access the User Manual for the SuperSail Owner App.

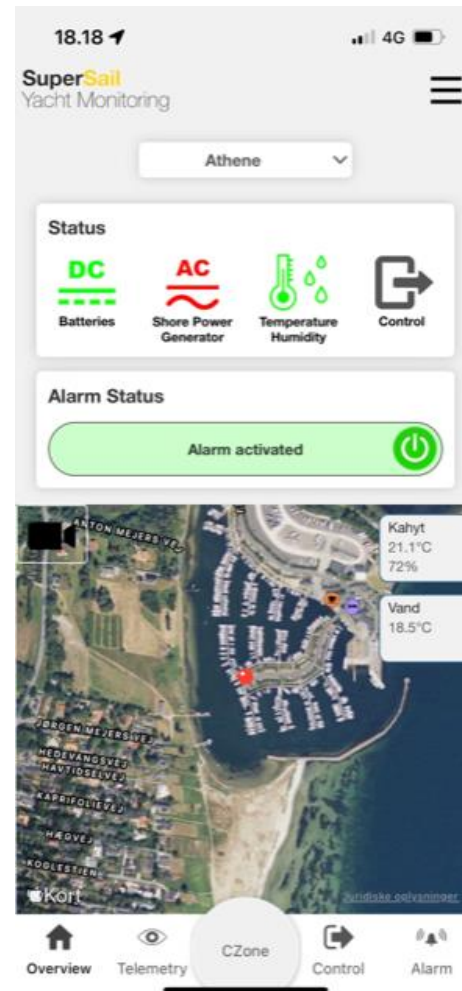
The new SuperSail App frontpage.

Quick Yacht Overview

5 Navigation Buttons



Quick Yacht Overview:

On top of the frontpage you find a quick overview of the status onboard your Yacht:



Will be green if all batteries monitored are ok. Red if one or more battery is outside the healthy Voltage range.



Will be green if 110V/ 230V generator (if monitored) and /or shore power is ok. Red if generator and/ or shore power are disconnected/ malfunctioning and grey if sensors for monitoring of these are not installed.



Will be green if the temperature and/ or humidity are within the user specified limits. Red if the temperature and/ or the humidity are outside the user specified limits and grey if sensors for monitoring of these are not installed.



Will be green if one of the Control outputs are active and grey if no Controls outputs are set active.

Alarm ON / OFF:

The slider has been moved to the front page:

- The slider will be green when the alarm is activated
- The slider will be orange when the alarm is deactivated

Yacht location & Tour History:

The map shows the position of your boat and if you are monitoring more than one boat you can see the position of all the boats monitored via the App. Also, your tour history can be accessed by tapping on the map and defining the calendar interval for which you want to see your tour history.

The five navigation buttons:



Returns to the frontpage



Gives access to detailed telemetry information like battery status and volage history, shore power status, engine and generator hours, tank status.

Depends on which sensors are installed!

At the bottom of the Telemetry page, you will find DOCUMENTS which gives you access to the User Manual, Installation Manuals and a Battery Shopping list for the wireless sensors.



Using the CZone™ button requires that your yacht is equipped with **CZone™ digital switching system**. The new SuperSail Owner App then enables you to remote control all CZone™ controlled onboard functions. I.e., the new X-Power from X-Yachts is equipped with CZone digital switching and can be remote controlled via the SuperSail Owner App.



Using the remote control requires that your Yacht is equipped with the SuperSail Monitoring Unit C (M-Unit-C - grey box) or the SuperSail 4-Device-Control box. This is where you define your alarm settings i.e., geofencing, sensitivity of the chock sensor etc. and you can connect up to 50 Wireless sensors to your Yacht Monitoring System

The Integrated SuperSail Camera Solution:

The SuperSail Owner App. supports the integrated SuperSail Yacht Camera Solution which enables you to access up to 8 IP cameras on-board.

If the Camera Solution is activated, you will find a Camera icon on the map on the front page.

Temperature and Humidity Sensors:

The SuperSail Owner App. supports measuring and controlling temperature and humidity on-board. The actual Temperature and humidity can be seen on the map section on the Frontpage.

Finally please remember

- The battery level in the wireless sensors is measured every time the sensor is activated (i.e. every time you pass by the movement sensor, opens a hatch etc. - both when the alarm is ON and OFF) and an SMS is sent if the battery level in a wireless sensor is too low. However, we still **recommend changing batteries in all wireless sensors once every year** in order to ensure optimal signal and security.
- If a temperature/ humidity sensor is attached, the temperature ikon figures will be shown in red, in case the temperature is not updated, i.e., if the sensor has run out of battery.
- When shopping for new batteries - Press [DOCUMENTS](#) and you will find an overview which specifies which batteries are needed for each of your SuperSail Wireless sensors.

What to do:

- From AppStore for iOS telephones and from PlayStore for Android telephones you will **receive a notification** when the new SuperSail Version 3.0 App. is available.
- Your settings will **not be changed** when you install the new App.
- When the App. is installed you just **use your present login**.
- We **recommend that you update to the new Version 3.0** in order to ensure that the latest security updates will be applied.
