Shortly SuperSail will release the new SuperSail App, Version 2.4.

We experience continued and significant interest in our solutions for monitoring both sailing and motor yachts of all sizes and lately we have started supplying Yacht Monitoring solutions to some of the most prestigious Yachbuilders worldvide.

The 2018 SuperSail App:

Our new Version 2.4 of the SuperSail App will be released to AppStore and PlayStore within a few days.

New functions and features:

- The battery level in the wireless sensors are now measured <u>every time</u>
 the sensor is activated (ie. every time you pass by the movement sensor,
 opens a hatch etc. both when the alarm is ON and OFF) and an SMS is
 send if the battery level is too low. However we still recommend to
 change batteries in all wireless sensors once every year in order to
 ensure optimal signal and security.
- The Alarm Status buttom is now shown with a <u>red ikon</u>, if the connection to the alarm is lost, ie. no GSM signal or the alarm has run out of power.
- The User Settings buttom is now shown with a <u>red ikon</u> in case no mobile telephone numbers are entered into the alarm recipient list.
- If a temperature sensor is attached, the temperature ikon now will be shown in red, in case the temperature is not updated, ie. if the sensor has run out of battery.



What to do:

- From AppStore for iOS telephones and from PlayStore for Android telephones you will receive a notification when the new SuperSail Version 2.4 App. is available.
- Your settings will **not be changed** when you install the new App.
- When the App. is installed you just use your present login.
- We recommend that you update to the new Version 2.4 in order to ensure that the latest security updates will be applied.

Our many sensors can easily be retrofitted and thereby further improving the monitoring of your yacht.

A **SuperSail water sensor** is a very good safety measure in your yacht, in order to give you an early warning in case a hose leaks, water tank leaks or in case a sea-valve is damaged by frost, corrosion etc.

A **SuperSail temperature sensor** which shows the actual temperature in your yacht can give you a "overheat" or frost alarm – you determine the limits.

In addition many of our SuperSail users are very satisfied with the ability to switch on the deck light via the remote control when boarding the yacht at night. In addition many SuperSail users are using the App.to remote control the heating, cooling in order to ensure that the yacht is ready and comfortable on arrival. This is all possible if you install our remote controlled **SuperSail 4 Device Control Box** which includes 4 build in relays ready to connect to your SuperSail Marine Alarm.
